



Sampled per Year




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Sample: Earliest Tombstone per Graveyard







Usage of Granite vs. Basalt on Penghu



Usage of Granite vs. Mudstone in Kaohsiung





Tools: Penghu Yang





Tools: Number of Characters (生老病死苦)









The Tanghao: Usage



The Tanghao: Onset













Previous Research, e.g. Wolfgang Franke



Previous Research, e.g. Wolfgang Franke



Factor: Hot Spots (thematic): GU




